

## Questions for Gruffalo Story

### Level one

- Where is the mouse/fox/tree etc
- Show me the .....
- Find another one like this (tree/flower etc)
- What can you see in the river/climbing up the tree/on the ground?

### Level two

- Which one can fly?
- Find me something that is growing.
- Show me something brown and white.
- The owl/snake says.....? Do you know what a fox says?
- What's different about the snake and the mouse?
- What is the little mouse doing at the end of story?
- Fox live live?
- What is the frog doing?
- Tell me some things that you can do in a river?
- Do you know what you call a place where there are lots of trees?

### Level three

- A sheep gives us wool – can we get anything from a fox or an owl or a snake?
- What can a fox/owl/snake/mouse eat?
- How are the mouse and the Gruffalo the same?
- What are prickles/what is a wart?
- What might the Gruffalo do next?
- Talk to child about trees being planted, then say 'tell me how the forest man planted the trees'.
- What do you think might be under the big stones?

### Level four

- (Explain first what is happening in picture) – why does the snake/fox/owl want the little mouse to come home with them? How will the farmer get the horse back in the field?
- Why do frogs like to live near water?
- Why is the woodpecker pecking on the tree?
- How do you think all the logs got where they are?
- Why did the woodcutter cut them down?
- Can you tell me some things that are made from wood?
- Why do they think the little mouse told everyone he knew a Gruffalo?
- How do they think the little mouse felt when the Gruffalo actually turned up?
- Why does the owl/fox/snake go away when the mouse tells him what the Gruffalo is like?
