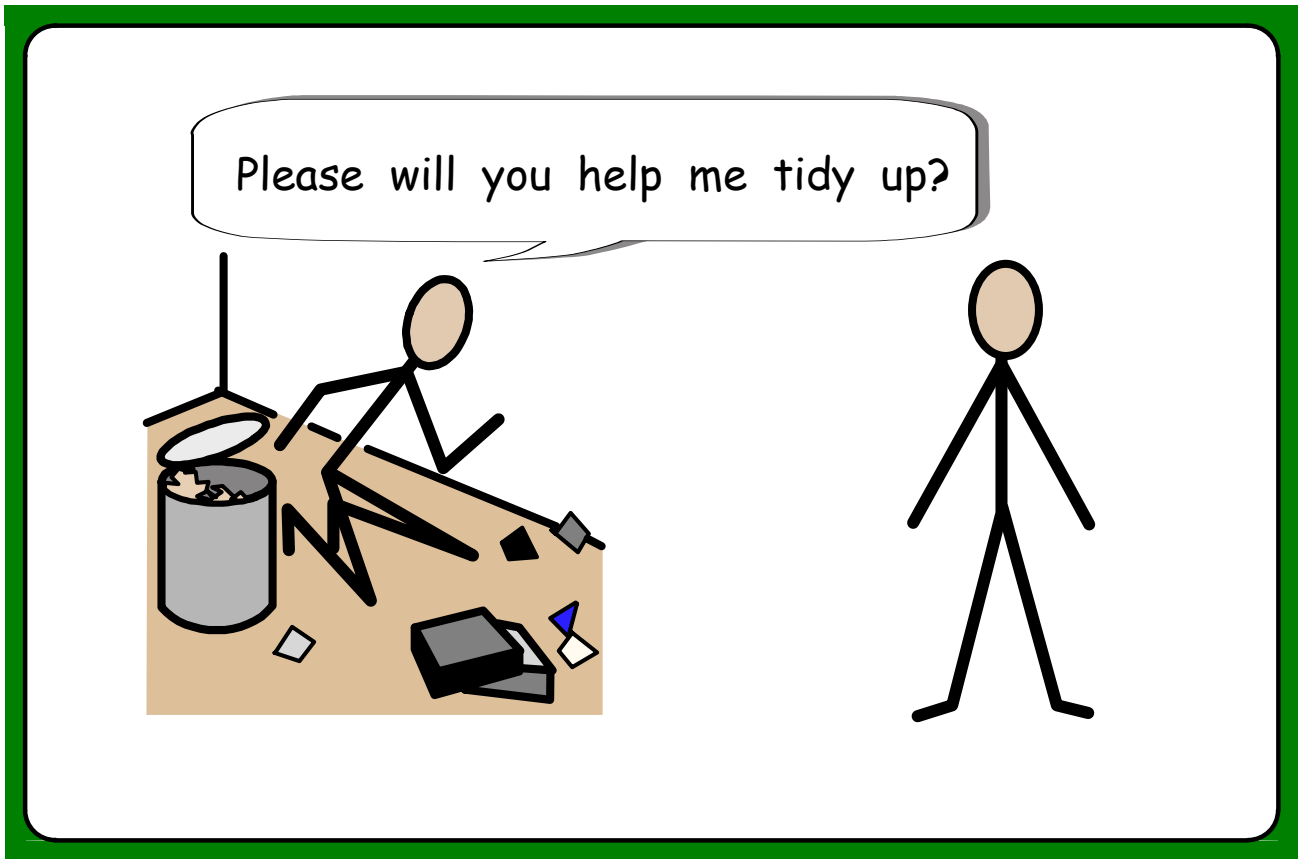
Good Manners

When we would like to have something we ask, "Please may I have.....?"

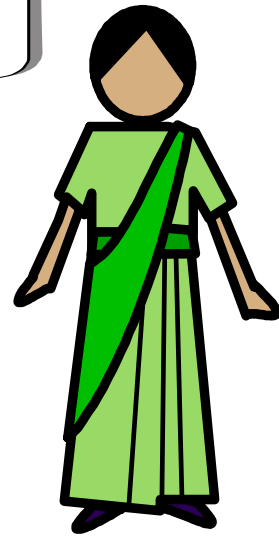
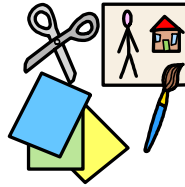
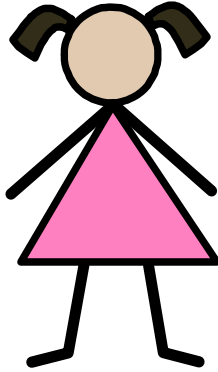
That is good manners.



When we would like somebody to do something for us we ask, "Please will you...?" or "Please can you...?"

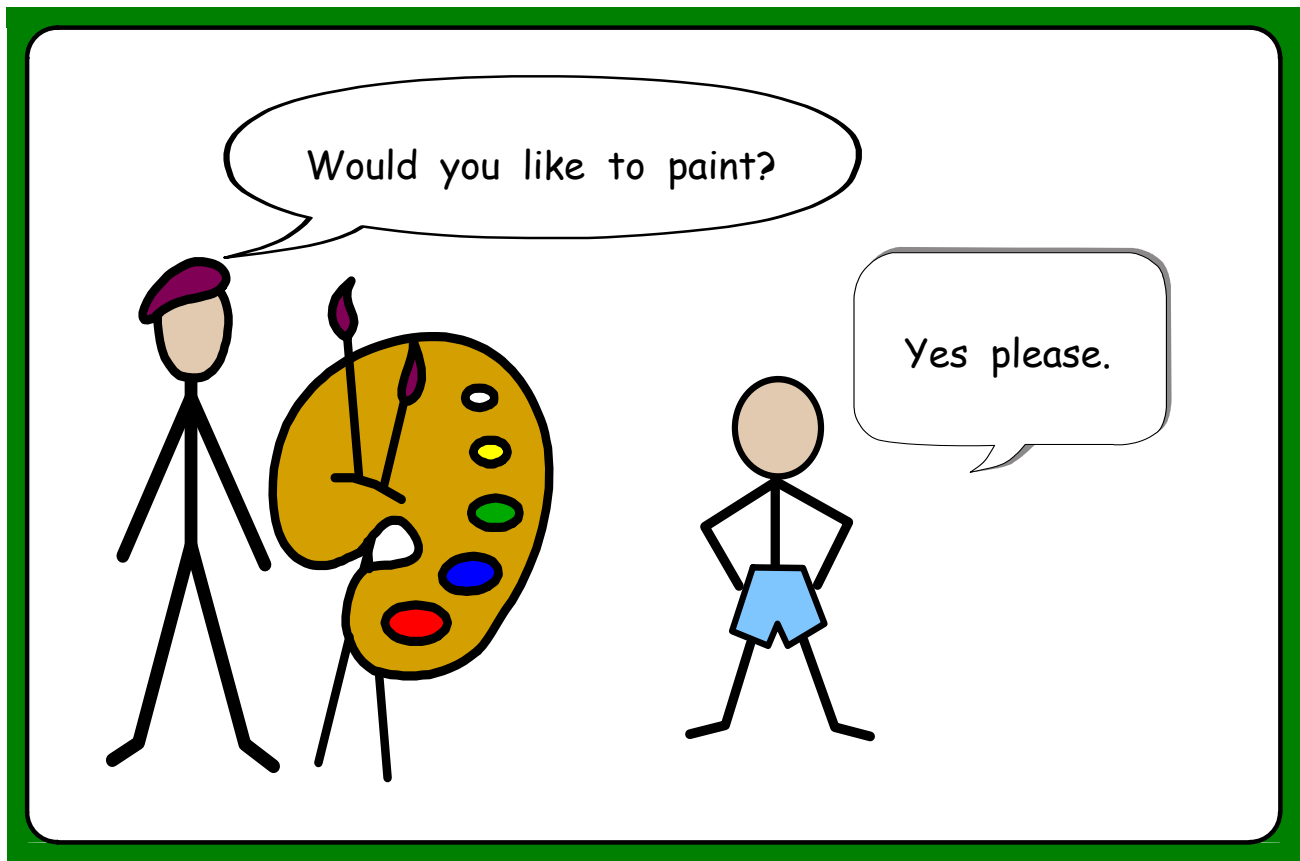
That is good manners.

Please may I do some craft work?



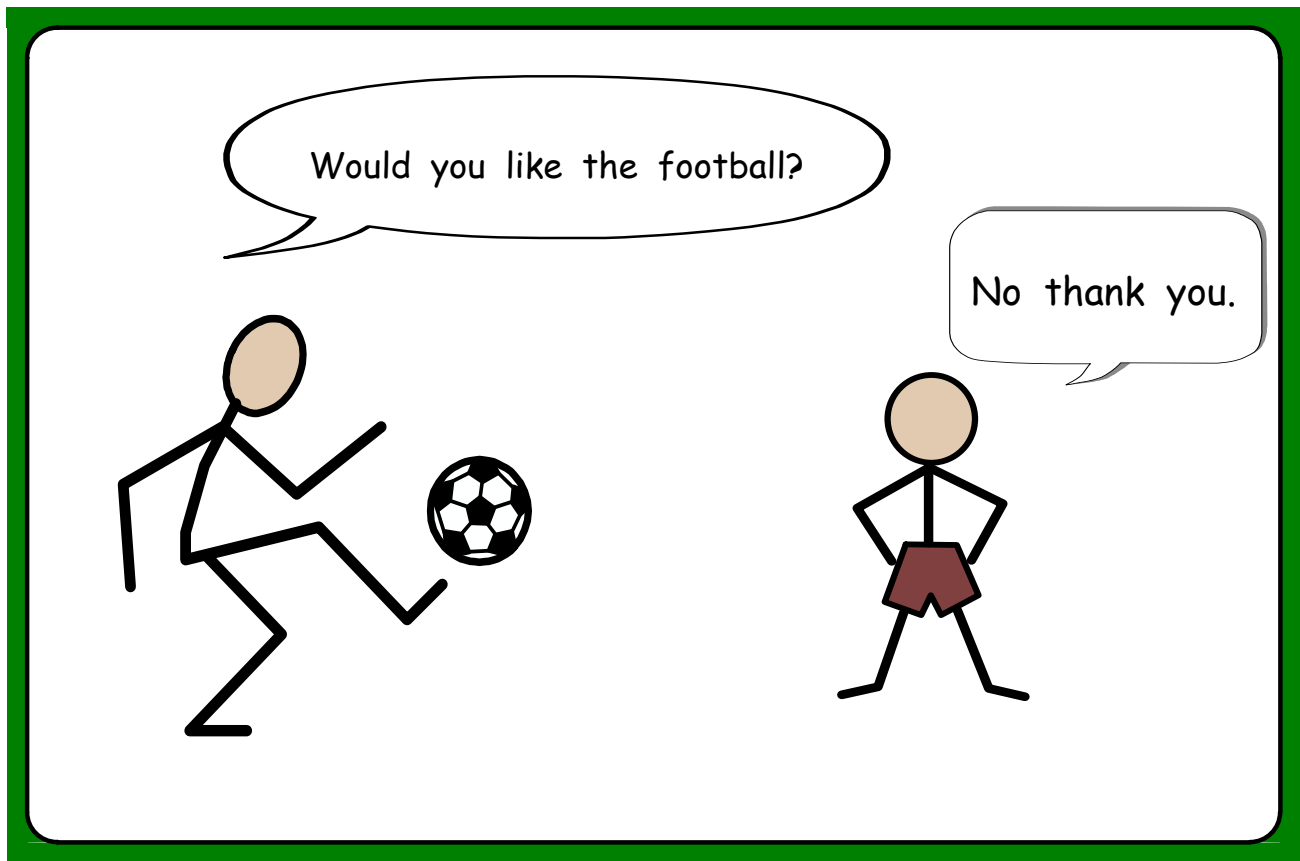
When we would like to do something we ask, "Please may I.....?"

That is good manners.



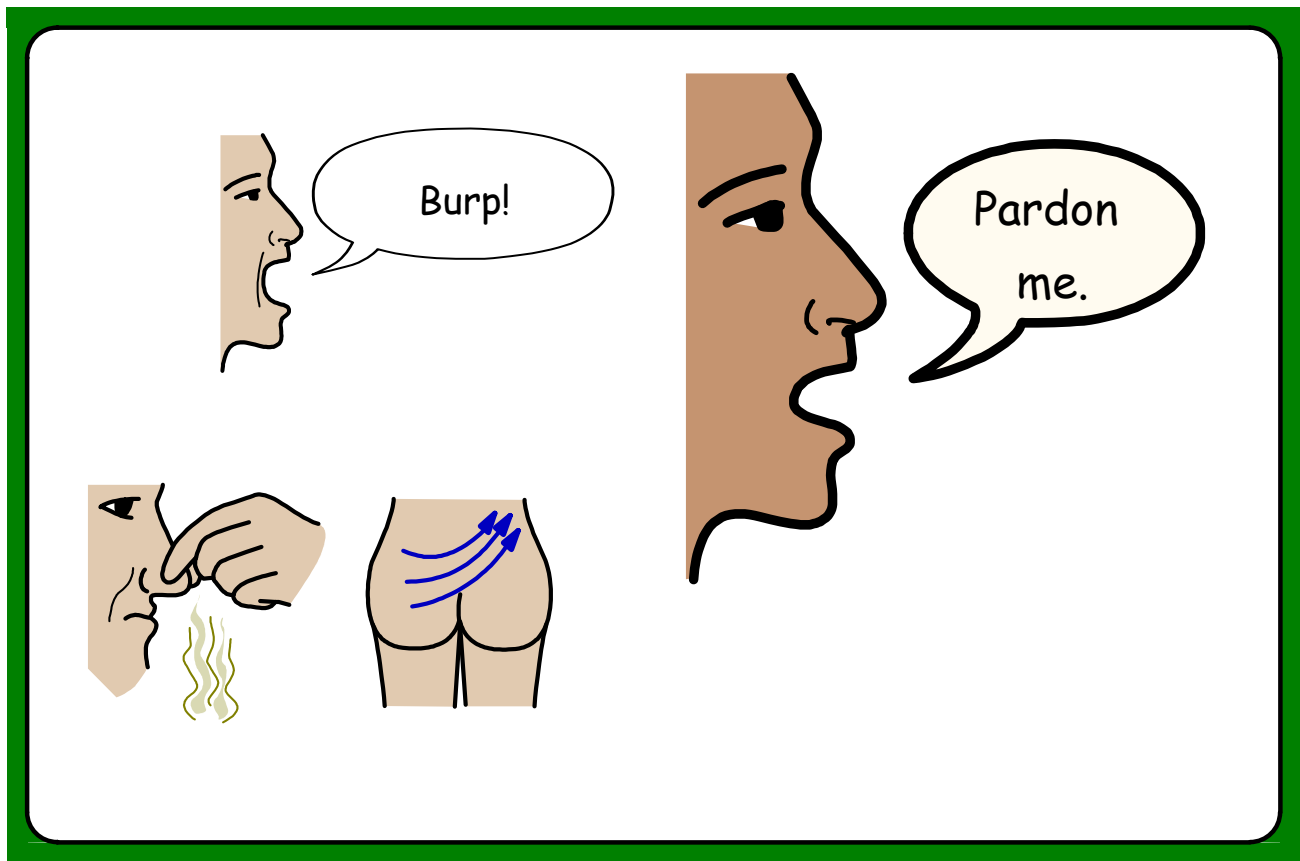
When somebody offers us something, and we would **not** like to have it or do it, we say, "No thank you."

That is good manners.



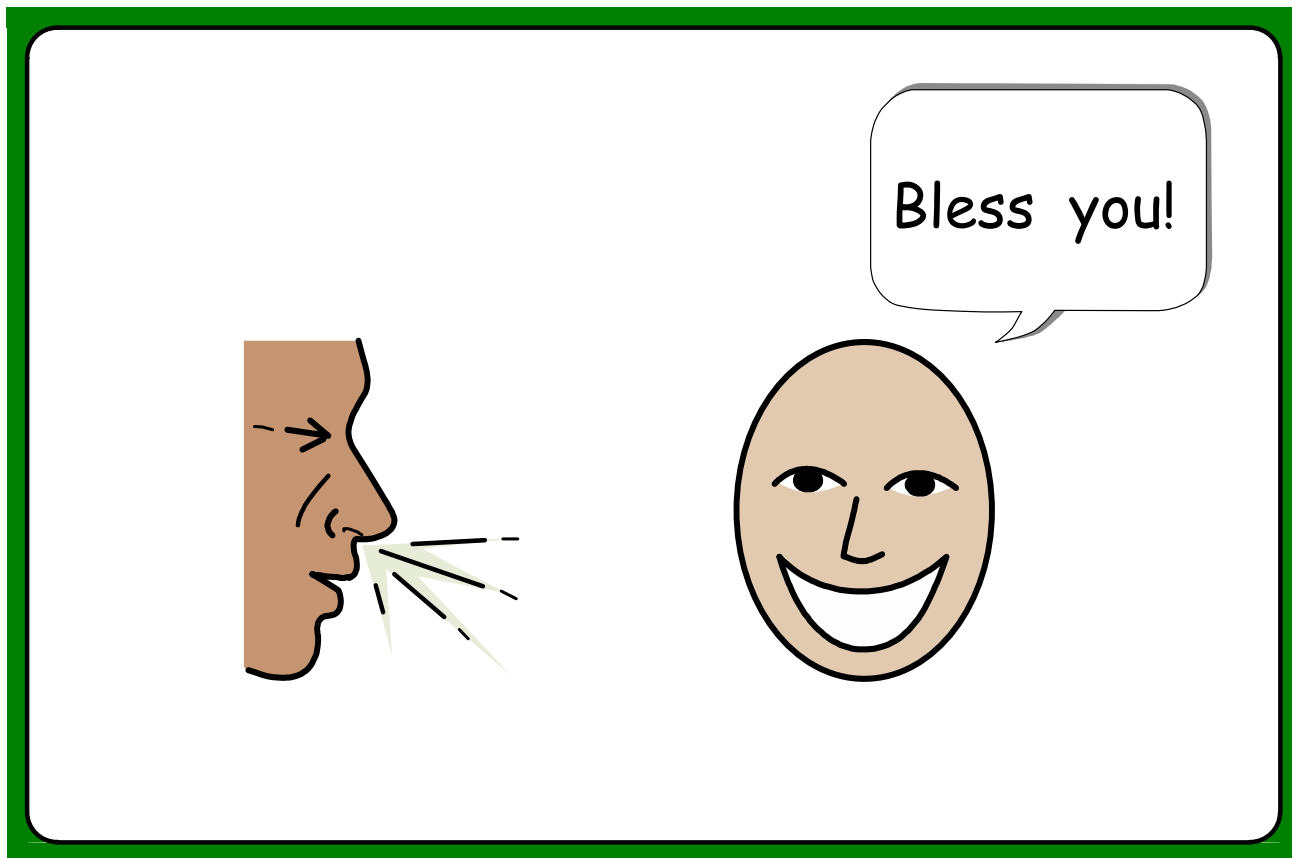
When somebody gives us something we say, "Thank you."

That is good manners.



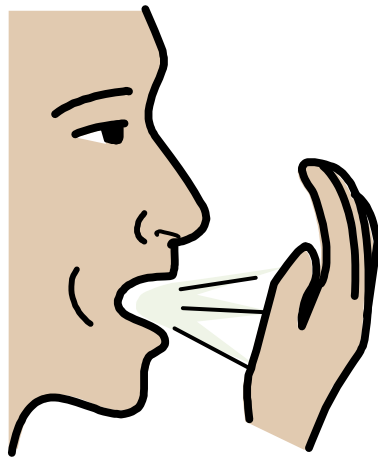
When we burp or do a pop we say "Pardon me."

That is good manners.



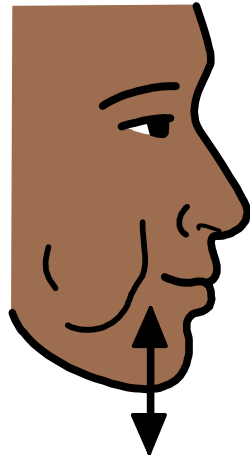
When somebody sneezes, we

That is good manners.



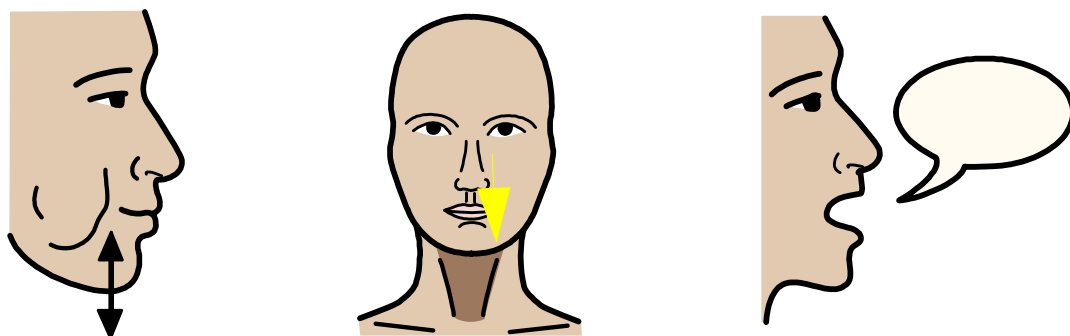
When we cough we cover our mouths so that we don't spread our germs.

When we eat we keep our mouths closed so that nobody sees the food being chewed inside our mouth.

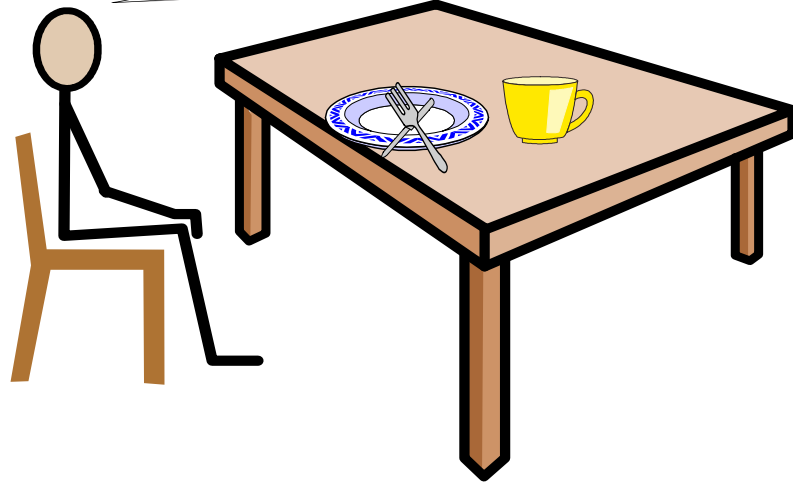
That is good manners.

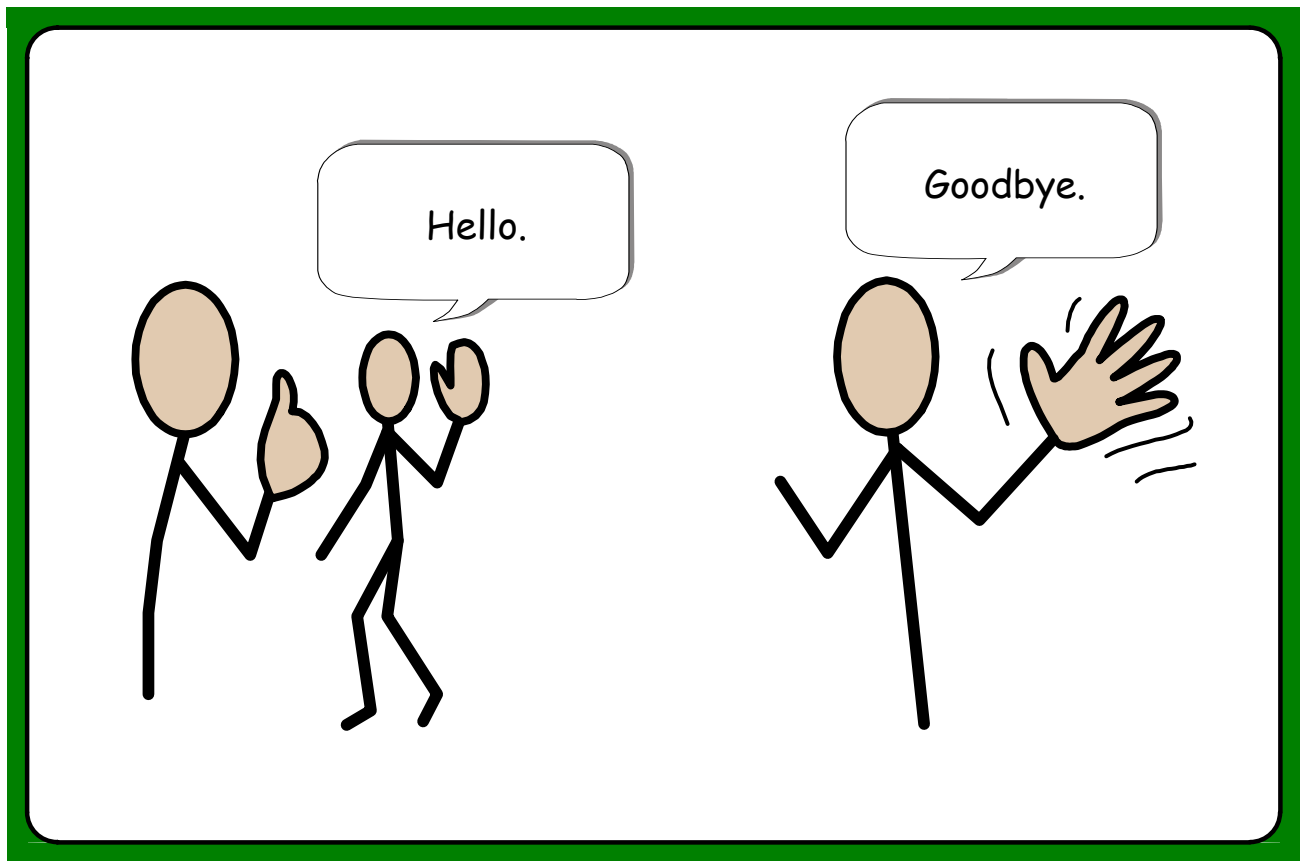
That is good manners.

That is good manners.



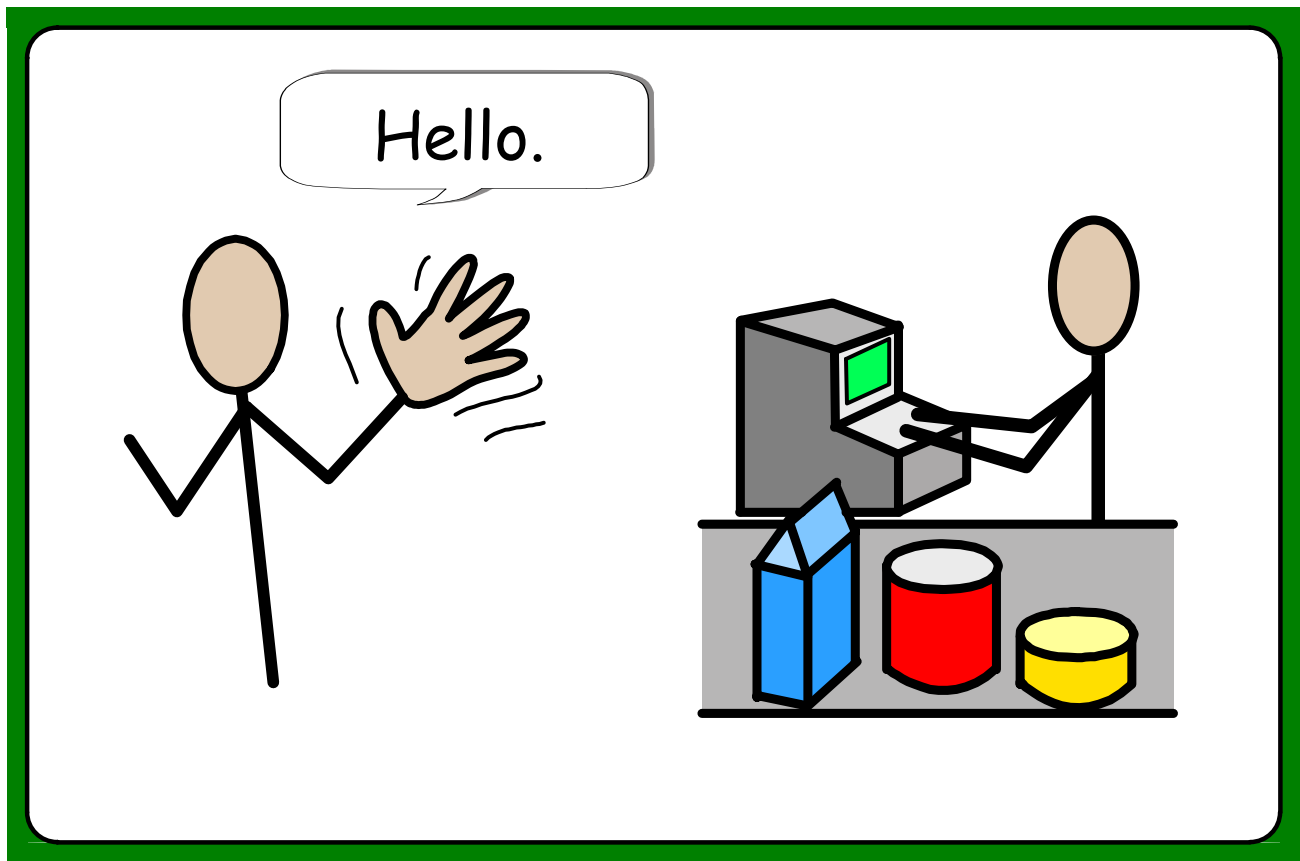
When we see people we know

That is good manners.



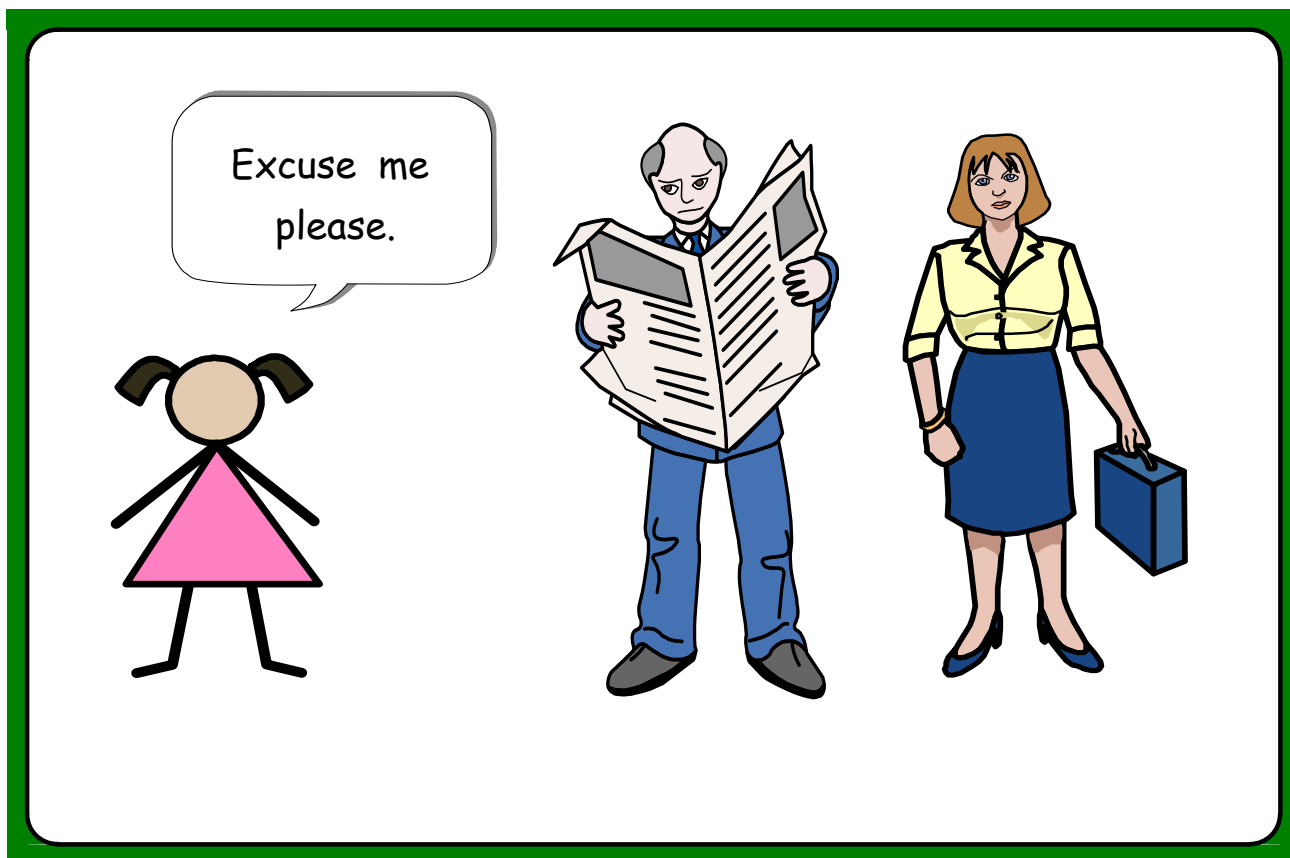

That is good manners.



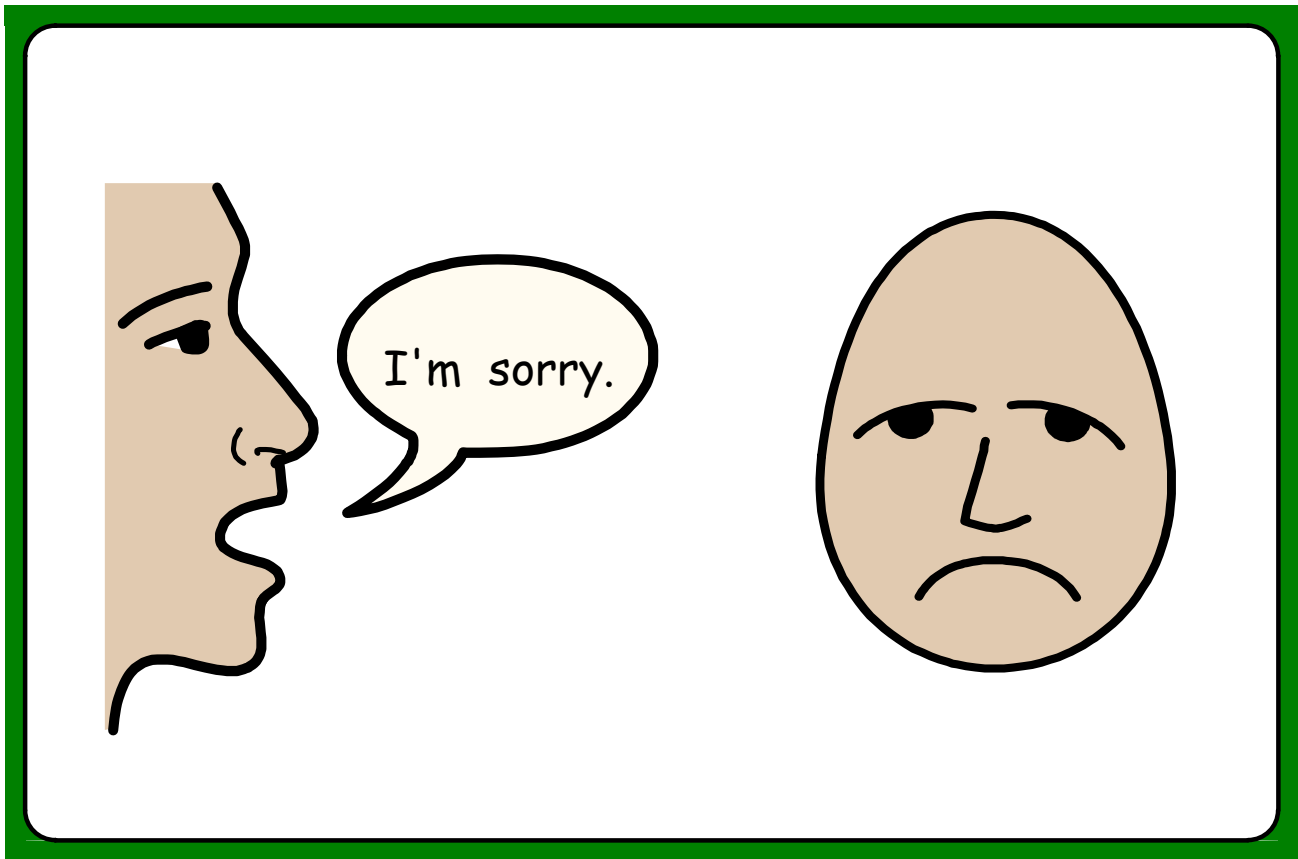
When we pay for things in shops we say "Hello," and "Goodbye," to the person at the checkout.

That is good manners.



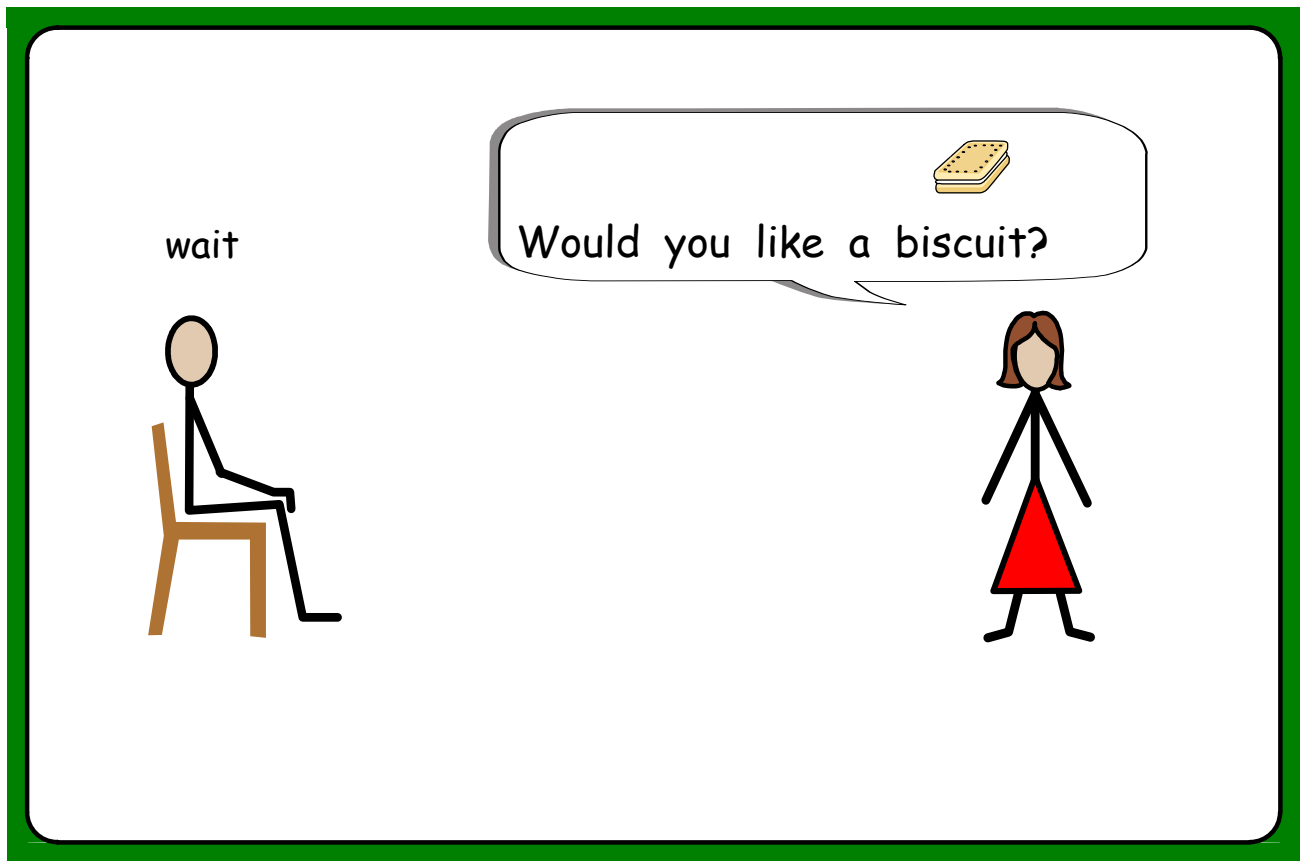
When somebody is in our way and we need them to move we say, "Excuse me please." When they move we can say, "Thank you."

That is good manners.



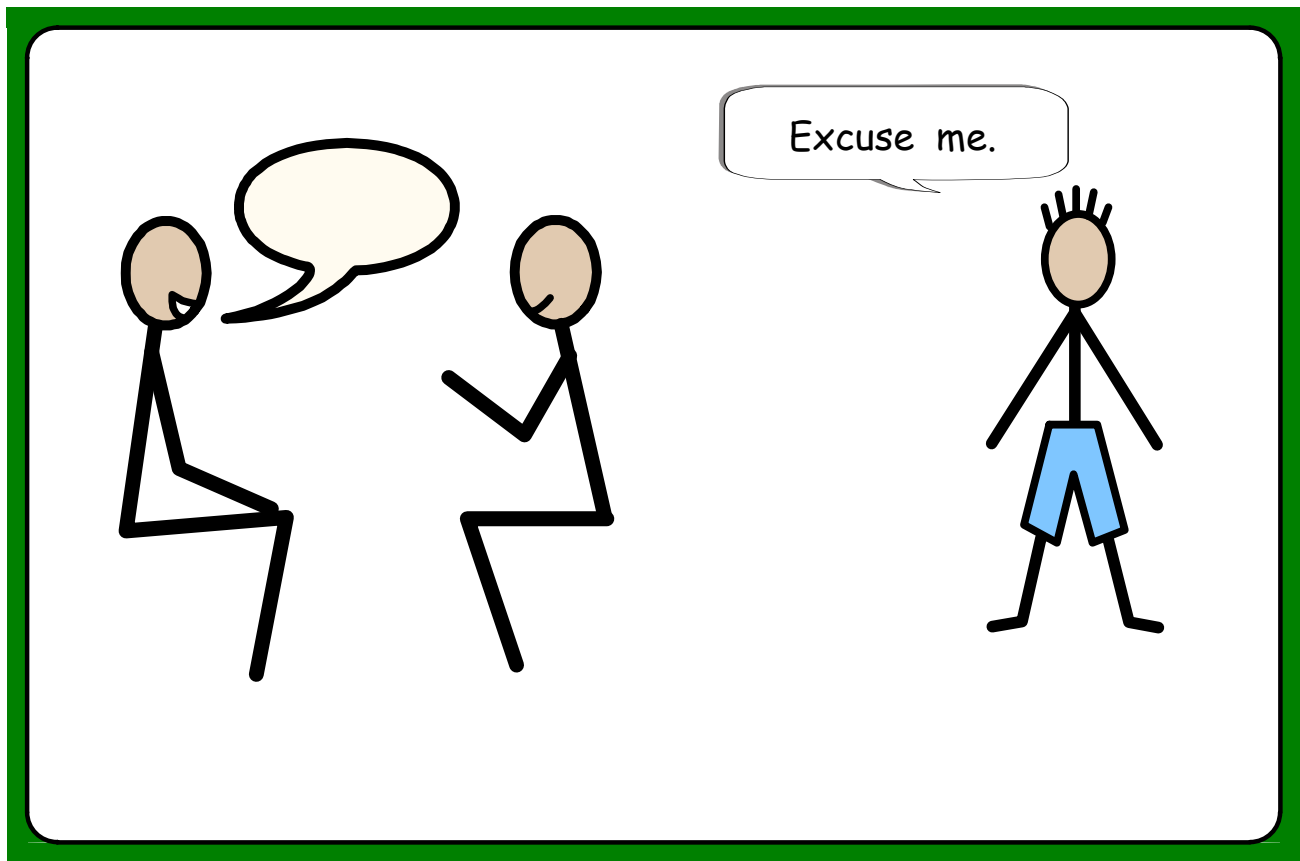
When we make a mistake we

That is good manners.



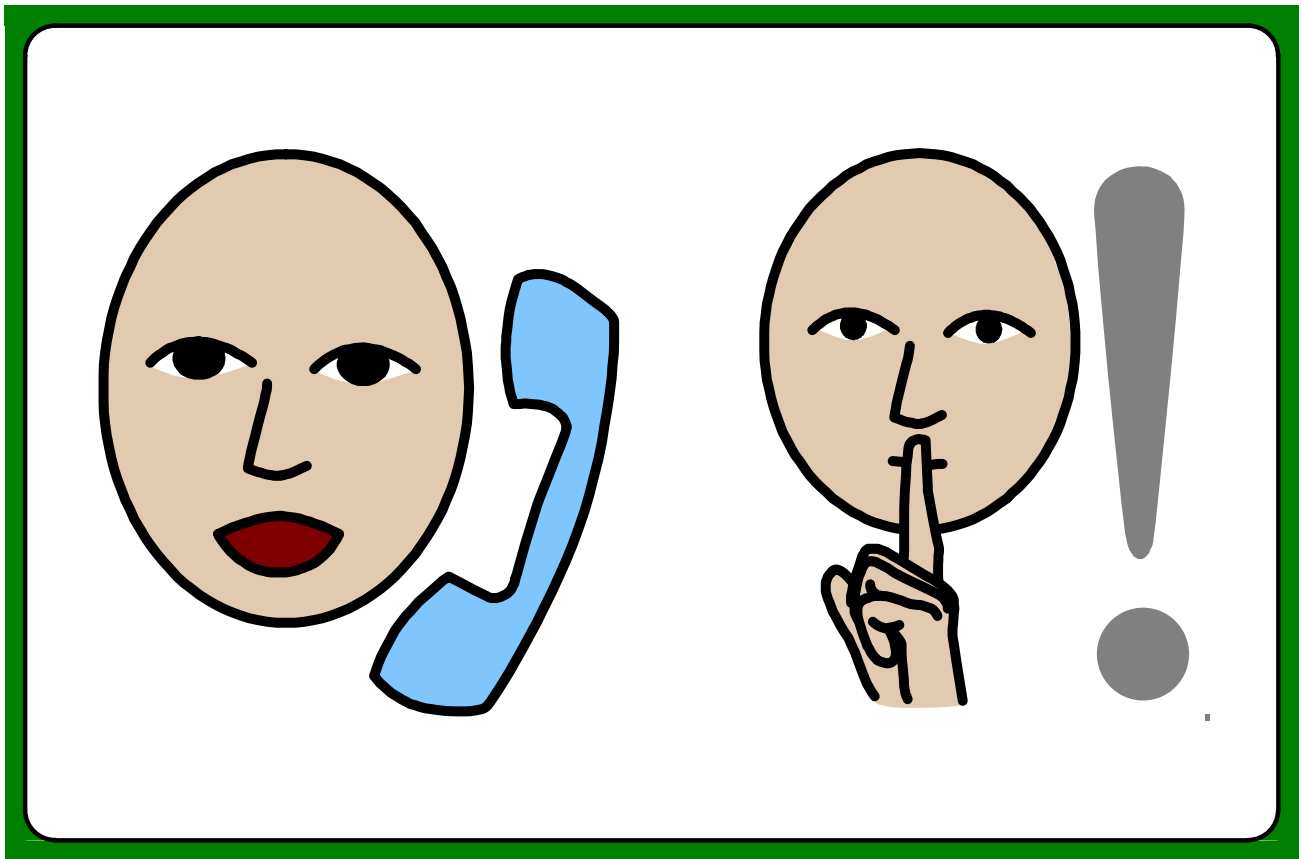
When we visit somebody else's house we wait to be offered food and drink. If we are really thirsty we can ask for some water.

That is good manners.



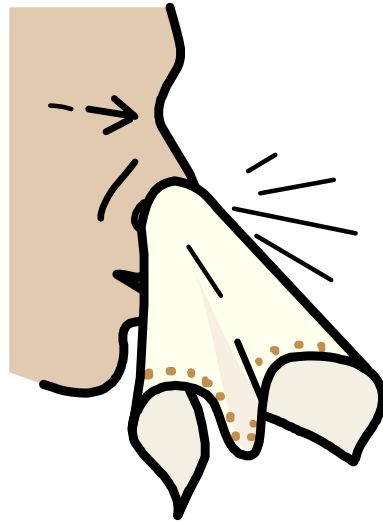
When people are talking and we need to say something important, we say "Excuse me," and wait until the person is ready to speak to us.
