Shiver me timbers! Can you find evidence of pirates lurking in the woods?

A leaf you could wear as an **eye patch**

Cutlasses, swords and daggers (sticks to use in a sword-fight)

Animal bones (like the **skull** and **crossbones** from the Jolly Roger pirate flag)

Something that glints in the sun like **pieces of eight**

A **cannonball** fired from a pirate ship

A branch that a pirate could use for a **peg leg**

Gold (natural treasures like autumn leaves and dazzling flower petals)

Something heavy enough to **anchor** a ship

A **plank** for scallywags to walk

A circular view like a **porthole**

A **crow's nest** (a nest high in the trees which would make a good look-out)

A tall, straight tree like a **ship's mast** – strong enough to hoist a sail from

A **hook-shaped twig** a pirate might use to replace his lost hand

Something small a pirate could wear as an **earring**

A **bottle of grog** (pirate litter eg bottles or cans)

A feather from a pirate's **parrot**

X marks the spot – look for crossed fallen twigs which might indicate buried treasure...
